

Enjoy a slice of Life

Egg and Cress, homemade Strawberry Jam, Chicken Tikka, Bacon, Cheese'N'Pickle; what is your favourite filling? Cucumber with the crusts daintily cut off, French cheese oozing out a crusty baguette or smoked salmon on wholemeal; the list is endless...as to what you might choose to tuck into the next time you fancy a lovely, tasty **Portsmouth**?

What? Let me explain.

When John Montagu's great grandfather was ennobled, he *almost* chose to take the title Earl of Portsmouth, and only on reflection favoured the smaller seaport of Sandwich instead. So might the 18<sup>th</sup> Century fast food craze to which Montagu gave his name been immortalized as the Portsmouth.

The Earl cannot, of course have been the first person to put a tasty morsel between slices of bread for convenience, any more than Jesus invented bread, but by identifying himself with it Our Lord elevated it to another dimension, gave it a new meaning.

Jesus fed the hungry and sharpened the appetites of his listeners but with more than sardine sandwiches. Jesus did not simply want to fill stomachs but hearts, minds and lives too. Bread, sometimes dry but always dependable, able to hold so much together, - do we take God, as we take bread a little too much for granted? 'Man cannot live by bread alone' says the Jesus who claims 'I am the Bread of Life'

Montagu also of course gave the English language a *verb*, sandwich meaning to squeeze in between. Sometimes faith becomes something we just squeeze in between the bread and butter of so-called real life, rather than more basic to what keeps us truly alive. Jesus knew and rejected that temptation.

The season of Lent is an opportunity for us to renew our appetite for God and put faith right back where it belongs at the centre in preparation for the feast of Easter.

#### RUSPER'S NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN NEW WORKING GROUP

#### Get involved in planning Rusper's future

Rusper's Neighbourhood Plan was adopted by Horsham District Council (HDC) in 2021: https://www.horsham.gov.uk/planning/neighbourhood-planning/rusper

It's likely, however, that HDC's new Local Plan will have significant implications for Rusper, and make key areas of our current Neighbourhood Plan redundant. Previous drafts of the Local Plan include the allocation of land West of Ifield for 3,000 houses, with the expectation of a further 7,000 houses from Lambs Green to Faygate and Ifield.

The best way for us to collectively respond to HDC's Local Plan is via a Working Group of residents and parish councillors to review it and to propose responses. These could then be discussed and submitted to HDC by Rusper Parish Council. The Working Group would also redraft the relevant areas of our Neighbourhood Plan, once a new Local Plan for Horsham District is adopted.

We're looking for volunteers to join the Working Group. All skills and experience would be welcome: organisational, administrative, analytical, drafting and editing, as well as specialist knowledge in areas such as planning, ecology and wildlife, climate change, transport policy, housing, etc. Most importantly we need volunteers with a love of the area and ideas to help keep it as a great place to live and grow.




