



Consider the Lilies

The image of the king in all his coronation splendour is still fresh in our minds. It is similar to a picture painted by Jesus in anxious times and contrasted with another kind of glory. 'If God so clothes the grass of the fields....then do not worry.' *

This month Rusper Church invites you to pause and enjoy some of our village gardens. A passage from the autobiography of St Therese of Lisieux comes to mind:

'Every flower created by God is beautiful. The brilliance of the rose and the whiteness of the lily do not lessen the perfume of the violet or the sweet simplicity of the daisy. I understood that if all the lowly flowers wished to be roses, nature would lose its springtide beauty, and there would no longer be any little flowers to make a pattern across the countryside. And so it is in the world of souls, Our Lord's living garden. He has been pleased to create great Saints who may be compared to the lily and the rose, but He has also created lesser ones, who must be content to be daisies or simple violets flowering at His Feet, and whose mission it is to gladden His Divine Eyes when He looks down on them. And the more gladly they do His Will the greater is their perfection.'

RUSPER CHRONICLE

What a lovely street party we had to mark the Coronation. But how did Rusper celebrate in 1953 – and 1937? At our May meeting Hazel, who was involved with the planning of our party, shared what she knew of Rusper's celebrations from newspaper reports and Parish magazines.

In 1953 Diana de la Rue wrote in her diary that despite the unseasonable cold and intermittent rain the programme was successfully carried out, with the dancing display and the children's sports taking place in the Village Hall – the rest of the events were at Normans, with fireworks and a bonfire. An intriguing competition was for the best decorated perambulator – and the silver spoon given to any baby born on Coronation Day seemed unlikely to get many claimants. Lady de la Rue wrote a strong letter of protest to West Sussex County Council on their decision not to give individual souvenirs to schoolchildren in the County. Instead, they granted each school the princely sum of £7 to buy some permanent commemoration. So Rusper did its own thing as usual.

The Church gave each child a small red Bible, inscribed by the Rector, and through the generosity of others in the parish each child received a mug – not the bog-standard mug but a superior one made by Midwinter. These were still cherished as both were passed round for us to admire. The Church appealed for a new carpet and received other useful gifts too, but overall did not make a fuss of the Coronation in the Parish News.

Not much is known about 1937 except for the usual sports day, held in Normans Park. Fancy dress prizes were for the Most Artistic dress and the Best Comedy dress. The farmers' cart horse race (no saddles, spurs or whips) was the highlight of the races. Fireworks were deemed too expensive. There is no mention of mugs or Bibles or tea parties- but if you know better, we'd like to know.

On display were various souvenir items from 1953, including scarves, tablecloths and stand-up models of the Coronation Procession.

Summary of Rusper Parish Council meeting & Planning Committee meeting – April 2023

The Combined Council and Planning Meeting took place on the 25th April 2023 Rusper Village Hall. Agreed responses to the following planning applications.

Public Forum

It was reported to the Council that there were extensive potholes in the area, as well as flooding along the Horsham

Road. The Clerk has advised the relevant authorities.

Report from other Authorities

District Councillor Liz Kitchen - a question was asked about the lack of leafleting from candidates for the upcoming election. Noted that leafleting was only used if necessary and there had been leaflet drops to the areas identified as necessary.

WSCC Katie Nagle— a resident from Lamb Greens reported that the surface of the road needed attention. This will be addressed along with the potholes in the area.

Active Planning Applications

DC/23/0669 Oaklees, Ashmore Lane, Rusper, West Sussex

Surgery to 1x Hornbeam the development type is TPO Tree application. No objection. **DC/23/0153 The**

Lamb Inn, Lambs Green, Rusper, West Sussex

Change of use of existing public house to form 4no. self-contained apartments and associated alterations. Objection. Loss of local amenity - The pub forms an important focal point for the hamlet of Lambs Green and would result in a significant change of character for the area. Loss of local employment - The Neighbourhood Plan encourages and supports employment in this rural area and the loss of this pub would have a significant impact.

Public notice - licensing application - Licensing Act 2003

An application has been received from Harry William Albert Slade for a new Premises Licence for Ashfolds, Horsham Road, Rusper, HORSHAM, RH12 4QX. The application proposes to apply for the following licensable activities, on Friday 1st, Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd September 2023. Objection. The prevention of public nuisance – 2am on 2 consecutive nights is too late for local residents. The Parish Council insists on environmental monitoring

as well during the event.

Procurement

Sports Ground Grant application - Cllr White will obtain a copy of the third bid. **Transport Consultation** the supplier has been appointed. The consultation is due to be received in a month.

Rusper Sports Clubs Terms of Reference/Lease

Lease was discussed with the Solicitor but further meetings are planned.

Highways

A report was issued in advance of the meeting, the Council accepted the report. Further updates on progress will be issued at the next meeting.

Reports from Representatives

Cllr Hanstad-Pilcher - attended 2 Police meetings one with the Inspector for the region; and has 2 meetings with the Police Crime Commissioners coming up.

Cllr Maitland-Smith – Litter Pick 2nd April 2023 was a success there was a good turnout of 25 people with 40 bags of litter collected.

Cllr Fillmore – a planning enforcement report was distributed in advance of the meeting. Gatwick meeting coming up in the next 2 weeks.

Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group (NPSG)

The NPSG met twice at The Plough, Rusper – there are 3 members of the public who currently attend with a further 4 interested in taking part following the session at the APM. A working plan is in place to make sure the NP is written in line with the new LP. 2 public events have been organised to gather public opinion; one was via the APM the other will be during the Coronation Street Party in May. Noted all Councillors are welcome to attend the

NPSG meetings, next meeting is on 17th May 2023.

Annual Parish Meeting 20th April 2023

About 40 people came to the event, there were 3 speakers HDC Wilder Horsham, David Bridges Wild about Warnham, SWOI Cathy Durrant and Cllr G Sallows spoke on behalf of the NPSG. **Financial** It was **RESOLVED** to approve the report, including the bank reconciliation

You may have noticed that there is now a greater acknowledgement in society that everyone can experience loneliness, whatever their age and whatever their situation. The experience of loneliness has been scientifically proven to have a detrimental impact upon health. There is a new service available called **Horsham District Befriends** which addresses this issue by matching people with a volunteer befriender who will over the course of up to 6 meetings help

people identify a community group to become involved with. The befriender is there to listen in a nonjudgmental way, to assist with allaying any anxieties, building confidence and supporting attendance at a new community group that suits the person's interests and needs. It sounds like such a positive initiative doesn't it? It's a service available to anyone over 18.
