



## Summer Saints or 'Some Are Saints?'

One of the signs of unity between the Church of England and that of Rome is the shared inheritance of those recognised as saints before the great splits of church history.

The feasts of John the Baptist, Peter, Justin, Boniface of Crediton and Alban which all take place in June are of those who were bloodily martyred, the last two being natives of this island. In fact, Alban is the first native Christian recorded as having willingly given his life, in substitution for the intended victim, a priest to whom he had given shelter from persecution. This took place during the Roman occupation on the site now occupied by the cathedral and city of St Albans. The word 'martyr' literally means witness, although its meaning has been narrowed to those witnesses who were violently killed. Perhaps only one of Jesus' twelve disciples met a natural death in old age. July sees the feasts of James and Thomas, but reminds us of other ways of following Jesus.

Saints are ordinary, flesh and blood people, not superstars or celebrities, but essentially human. What made them saints was not their natural abilities or personality, but the way they allowed God to be seen in them. The church has completed the cycle of Lent, Easter, Ascension and Whitsun. The saints are people of faith for all season and these Summer saints remind us that all, not just the few, are called to be holy.

#### **RUSPER CHRONICLE**

#### **Our Indian Connections**

"Born in Simla" – a small phrase on a gravestone in Rusper Churchyard started an investigation into Rusper's connections with India. And the discovery that we do have strong links with this faraway continent. We were glad of maps to help us explore! We looked at the stories of some of the people who went out to India as engineers, soldiers, members of the Indian Civil Service, as wives and mothers or who retired to live in Rusper. One who went but did not return was Katherine Broadwood, the eldest daughter of Henry Broadwood at Lyne House who died aged 32 in 1874 in Bengal. She is commemorated on a plaque on the north aisle of the church. Her husband and three young children returned to live at Pleystowe in Capel.

Thomas Dunn was an engineer who went out to India as a young man and amongst other successes built a road and rail bridge over the river Jumna at Allahabad which is still in use. He returned to Rusper to The Cottage (now Ghyll Manor) seriously ill and died in 1878 aged 44. His two youngest children were baptised in Rusper.

We had several distinguished soldiers who saw active service in India. These included General Sir Horace Searle-Anderson KCB, living at Seers Croft, Lt. General Sidney Chalmers, Major General Frederic Bond and also Lt. General Alexander Fraser CB living at Carylls. His wife Mrs Alexander Fraser was an unexpected find. Born in India in 1830, she became the writer of over 20 popular romantic novels with titles such as "A Fatal Passion", and supported her mother and children through her earnings after the breakdown of her marriage.

One sad story is that of little Margaret Georgiana Seton- Karr, born in India but died in 1868 aged 9 years in Earlswood Asylum. She is buried in Rusper. A happier story is that of Revd Hugh Trevaskis, Rector of Rusper from 1933 to 1948, who went out to India to join the Indian Civil Service in 1903. On long leave in Southampton some years later, on his way to a tennis party, he met his young future bride. She was only 17 but he proposed some weeks later and she followed him out to India, where they were married in Lahore Cathedral next day, the start of a long and happy marriage. "Born in Simla" is on the gravestone of their daughter Janet, known to us as Janet Wise.

### SAVE WEST OF IFIELD CAMPAIGN

You may have read that Horsham DC recently turned down a planning application for 800 houses on the Horsham Golf and Fitness site near Southwater. This is interesting for Rusper – facing 3,000 houses West of Ifield (WOI) – because the main reasons the HDC officers recommended refusal would seem to also apply to West of Ifield, and we hope the Planning Inspector examining HDC Local Plan (from June onwards) will agree. Those reasons include:

1. <u>Location</u> – the site is in the countryside, beyond a built-up area boundary. It is contrary to Southwater's Neighbourhood Plan and detracts from Southwater village. It "would significantly diminish the rural and tranquil character of this particular part of the landscape, creating a discordant and uncharacteristically urbanised environment harming the character and visual amenity of the countryside." **All this applies to WOI**.

2. <u>Transport infrastructure</u> – "The application has failed to demonstrate that safe and suitable access can be achieved for all users. The proposed routes for active travel to a range of key amenities are not suitable or attractive for general everyday use in terms of safety and personal security. Moreover, the necessary active travel infrastructure to support a sustainable form of development in this location is not proposed nor considered deliverable at the current time, such that the development will have a high reliance on motorised vehicles even for short journeys." All this applies, plus WOI does not have ready access to major roads such as the A24 or the Worthing Road.

3. <u>Noise</u> – "Insufficient information has been submitted to demonstrate that the amenity of the future occupants of the development would not be detrimentally impacted by noise disturbance from Worthing Road and the A24." **The same is true with regard to WOI and Gatwick noise**.

Horsham Golf and Fitness has <u>not</u> been allocated in HDC's draft Local Plan. But SWOI's planning consultant – Stuart Crossen –concluded that the Sustainability Appraisal in HDC's draft Local Plan is based on inaccurate information so that the comparisons between development sites are "anomalous" and West of Ifield "should also have been removed from the Regulation 19 version of the Plan". See Stuart's arguments, and his re-appraisal of the West of Ifield's sustainability on page 62 onwards our Reg 19 response here: <u>Exec summary + Spatial</u> <u>strategy</u>

Lastly, Homes England's objections to this application make for interesting reading – based on the reduction in number of golf holes affecting the viability of the WOI application, and a lack of robust water neutrality

We must ensure that HDC is consistent in its judgement of WOI.

**Climate Crisis** - The Council **acknowledged** that there is currently a climate crisis, and to ensure that all decisions made within meeting have consideration to this.

**Minutes of previous meeting - it was RESOLVED** to approve the Minutes meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2024 2024.

**Reports from other Authorities** - Introduction of the new County Councillor Stuart Damian for the Parish

#### **Rusper Sports Club**

Noted that the Sports Club tennis court works are under way and Cllr George Sallows will project manage each stage and report back to Council. The Council **acknowledged** the grant award of £4050 for the maintenance of the second tennis court and marking out of the basketball area.

#### Gatwick

DCO hearings are currently on now and ClIr Fillmore is attending them to observe on behalf of the Council. On 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 there is an open hearing with all MPs. Visit website for all Gatwick reports in full.

#### Streetlights

Cllr Marion Fenton consulted with the residents of Cooks Meadow and it was **agreed** that the residents wanted the new LED version of lights rather than to replace the older style lights. The quotation issued in advance of the meeting was accepted by Council.

#### **Local Plan Regulation 19**

There were 1700 responses to the Local Plan, hearings will take place in November/December, modification to the plan in February/March 2025 to be adopted in late Spring early Summer 2025.

It was reported to Council that there is a possibility that Homes England will put a Hybrid outline planning application for most of the proposal including the link road and for infrastructure in advance of the Local Plan. Noted that a lot of work is already in place following the objection made by the Council on the LP proposal and that should carry weight with the inspector.

#### **Reports from Representatives**

Cllr Simon White – update on 20mph speed consultation - everything is in place to support the reduction in speed through Rusper village but the Council needs the support from the Police.

Cllr Fenella Maitland-Smith – The Capitol is going to shut for 18 months so HDC want to offer venues to performances. Cllr Gat to let the Village Hall committee know.

Cllr Geoff Hussey – the flooding at The Mount due to a storm drain has now been planned for repair on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Noted new PSCO is due to start soon.

Cllr Gat – North Horsham Liaison Group meeting – there are going to be 600 houses to finish phase one and works will start on A261 again with one lane closed from new roundabout up until Christmas, some works will start next week.

#### Annual Parish Meeting 25<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

The meeting was poorly attended, and the Council are to consider removing the event from the calendar.

#### May Day

The road closure application on behalf of the May Day Committee has been applied for along with the road closure signage. Noted that in recent years the Council has received the money back for the road closure.

Next meetings are the Annual Council Meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2024 at 7pm and the Planning Committee Meeting on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2024 commencing at 7pm.


